## **The fight for Martin Luther King, Jr. Day**

**On January 15, the entire nation pauses in remembrance of a civil rights hero. At least, that's the point of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, a federal holiday that takes place on the third Monday of each January. MLK Day was designed to honor the activist and minister assassinated in 1968, whose accomplishment have continued to inspire generations of Americans. But though the holiday now graces the United states' federal calendar and affects countless offices, schools, businesses and other public and private spaces, it wasn't always observed. The fight for a holiday in Martin Luther King, Jr.'s honor was an epic struggle in and of itself- and it continues to face resistance in the form of competing holidays to leaders Confederacy.**

**King was the first modern private citizen to be honored with a federal holiday, and many familiar with his non-violent leadership of the civil right movement, it made sense to celebrate him. But for others, the suggestion that King- a black minister who was vilified during his life and gunned down when he was just 39 years old deserved a holiday was nothing short of incendiary.**
